When, where & how much?

- 1st-4th August 2007
 - Midday-midday
- Brownsea Island
 - Small wooded island, owned by the National Trust
 - Camping next to the original campsite
 - Poole Harbour (on the south coast)
 - Participants need to arrange their own travel to Poole Quay
- £165 Camp Fee
 - Including all activities, food, and camping equipment
- Bursaries & Grants available
 - Both for the camp fee and travel
